Purpose

- The introduction to your research project
- States your question
- Explains why you are doing this research
- Explains why the question matters

Purpose

- Asks your research question
- Answers the following question:
 - What are we studying?
 - Why was it an important question?
 - What did we know about it before I did this study?
 - How will this study advance our knowledge?"

Purpose

- Must be written using an academic voice
- Written as a cohesive paper
- Think of it as an argument for why your question needs to be researched.
- Do not present hypotheses, research, or findings
